WEEK 2: Colossians 1:24 – 2:23

### Shuffle the Deck

1. **Personal Letter.** Buy a stack of pre-paid postcards. Write notes to your friends and/or family and mail them. Decorate them if you wish. It's great to receive hand written letters.
2. **Family Member Hired.** Someone has answered your ad (from Week 1's Shuffle) to join your family and you've hired them. Write a brief user's manual for the job. Include rules of the house and benefits.
3. **Daily Digital 1.** With your digital camera or camera phone, take a picture of the EXACT same object everyday in the exact same place around the exact same time. Keep the photos on hand for a Shuffle found in Week 4. It is best if the object is organic or in an organic setting and something you can take a picture of EVERYDAY: a tree in your yard or other piece of landscaping, your face or the face of a family member, your breakfast meal, the surface in your house that collects all the mail, lunch bags, and keys, etc.

### Play Your Hand
